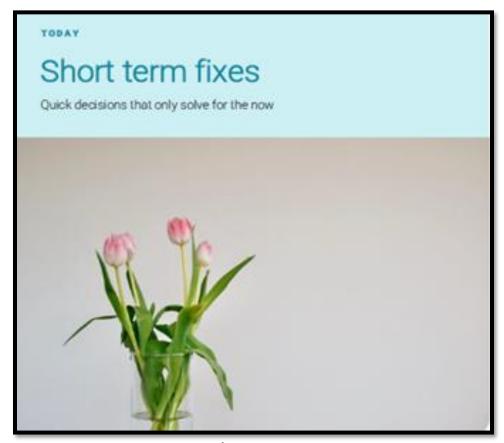

Underestimates That... 8 people die every day from accidents involving distracted driving It takes 30 seconds to respond to a text and 30 seconds to get into a accident.

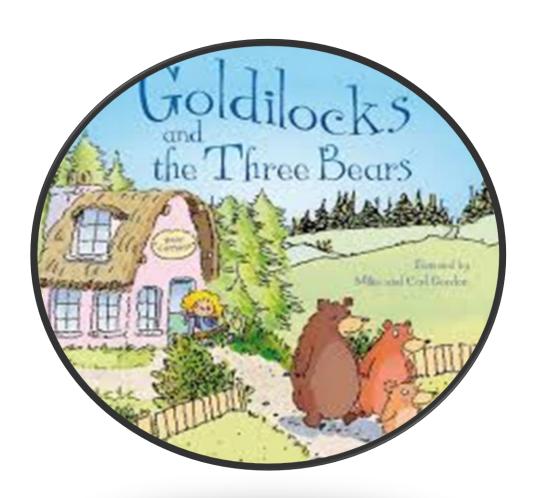

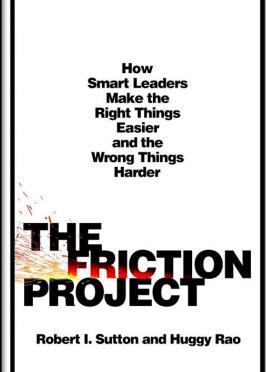




Consider the subtraction versus addition biases in change initiatives and skills.



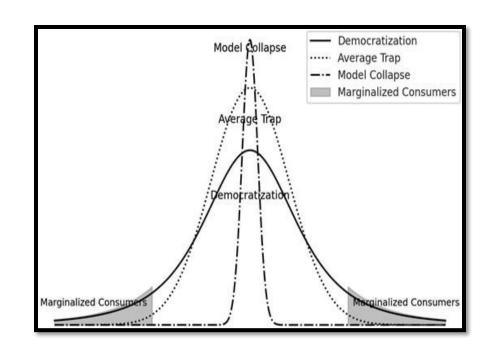


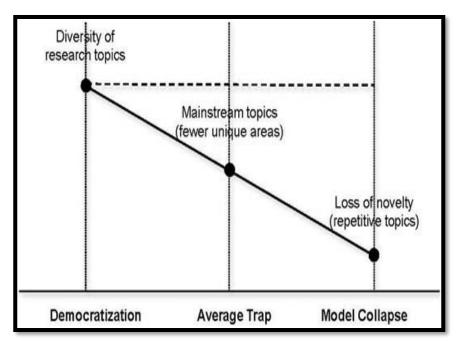


"In the world of software, people who add more and more features are often the people who get rewarded instead of those who subtract features or don't add them in the first place.
